## About

### Dover International Speedway®

Best known as the “Monster Mile®,” Dover International Speedway is a one-mile, high-banked oval in Dover, Del. The track has been a fixture on the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series schedule since its inception in 1969 and continues to host NASCAR’s three national touring series – the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series, the NASCAR Nationwide Series and the NASCAR Camping World Truck Series – as well as the NASCAR K&N Pro Series East, NASCAR’s top developmental series.



Each seat at the Monster Mile provides an excellent view of the action, but nothing can beat the privileged access of being on the concrete track. Now, you can gain a new perspective of the Monster Mile on non-race weekends and get behind the scenes at Dover International Speedway.

### A guided track tour may include some of these stops:

- The Monster Monument at Victory Plaza, presented by AAA
- Victory Lane
- An up close and personal view of the track and pit road
- A visit inside the Infield Media Center
- And more!

Souvenirs will be available for purchase at the conclusion of the tour. Cameras are encouraged and provide a great way to remember and relive your visit to the Monster Mile!

Your tour guide on most days will be George Keller, the track’s historian. Keller has not missed a race at the track since its inception in 1969. He has many a story and memory to share!



### Start Your Engines!

Tours cost \$7 per person for all ages and tickets can be purchased on the day of the tour. Cash or credit cards are accepted. Tour participants can use their admission pass to receive \$7 off any NASCAR Sprint Cup Series race ticket (May 16 & Sept. 26, 2010).



## 2010 Tour Dates

Tours are conducted on most Tuesdays at 10 a.m. and Thursdays at 2 p.m., weather permitting. All tours begin and end in the ticket office lobby (near parking lot E). A shuttle bus will be available to transport guests from the ticket office to the Monster Monument and entrance to the track. Tours will not be conducted on holidays or two weeks prior to each NASCAR race weekend (May & September).

## Caution Flag

- While there are no age limits to participate, please keep in mind that the tour takes place outdoors and may be physically demanding for some of our fans.
- For your safety, we ask that the group stay together while following the tour guide, and refrain from climbing up the banking of the track towards the wall. As you may know, the track is very steep (24 degrees in the turns) and potential injury could result.
- Occasionally, there may be debris on pit road or on the track itself. Please refrain from picking up debris as a souvenir, as some objects could be sharp or otherwise cause injury.
- All participants will be required to sign a liability waiver form at the beginning of the tour. Children under 18 require a minor release form that must be signed by the child’s parent or legal guardian.
